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BIG FALLS CAMPGROUND VISITOR GUIDELINES COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Welcome to the Big Falls Campground! The city is providing these guidelines for guests in an effort to make sure we comply with guidance given to us from MN DNR concerning safely re-opening campgrounds. We want all of our guests to have a pleasant experience, while maintaining a safe space for all visitors and staff.

1. **RECREATE WITH YOUR HOUSEHOLD.** MN DNR requests that you restrict use of your individual campsite/campfire to only those in your immediate household. If you or any member of your household is sick or experiencing symptoms, please stay home.
2. **BE SELF-SUFFICIENT.** Be prepared to be as self-contained as possible. Our restroom and shower facilities are CLOSED, so only RVs with on-board bathrooms will be allowed to camp in our park. One tent within the same site, with family members who have access to the RV, will be allowed. You will need to provide your own soap, surface disinfectant, hand sanitizer, toilet paper and towels.
3. **SOCIALLY DISTANCE YOURSELF.** To ensure that social distancing can be maintained, it is best to set up your campsite to maximize distance from adjacent campsites that host people from different households. Use of masks outside of your campsite is highly encouraged. Please stay 6 feet back if waiting in line at the pay station.
4. **GROUP FACILITIES.** The pavilions are available for single household use, with a limit of 10 persons maximum. These areas are not disinfected by staff, and you are required to use a sanitizer before and after use. Please leave all picnic tables and trash cans where you find them – do not move any fixtures.
5. **STAFF INTERACTIONS.** Per city COVID-19 policies, the host and staff have been instructed to limit all face-to-face contact with guests to emergency needs only. Please pay for your site at the self-pay station with the envelopes provided, posting the stub on your site post. If you are paying by credit or debit card on-line we still require you to fill out the envelope with the date and amount of payment made. The camp host will still be on-site to address any immediate needs. She may be reached at 218-556-4825.
